
Your application dated 22-03-2021 for grant of license for running Private Security agency in the name of M/s Delta 300 Ultimate Manpower Solutions Pvt. Ltd has been considered and you have been granted License no. PSA/L/68/DL/2021/DEC/3/689 to run the security agency from 30.12.2021 to 29.12.2026. The license, in original, has been enclosed.

Besides compliance of provision of PSAR Act and Rules, the following reports shall be submitted as prescribed.

1. Engagement of supervisors within two months of grant of license (section 9(3) of the PSARA Act. A list of the Supervisors shall be sent to this office.
2. The certificate of commencement of business within six months of obtaining the license (Section 9(1) of the PSARA Act).
3. The strength of deployment of security guard, duly trained as per Act and Rules, shall be informed to the department, every six months, from the date of issue of license by the department.

(The half yearly report as on 30th June and 31st December of every year shall be submitted within 15 days after the expiry of the six months period).

Non compliance of Rules & non submission of timely reports will attract penal action as per provisions of Law.

D.P.S.A.(R) RULES, 2009

1. A private security agency shall not employ or engage a person as a supervisor unless he fulfils the conditions specified in sub-section (1) of section 1
2. Every private security guard shall be issued a photo identity card, by the private security agency employing or engaging the guard
3. While engaging a supervisor of private security guards, every private security agency shall give preference to a person who has experience of serving in the Army, Navy, Air Force or any other Armed forces of the Union or State Police including armed constabularies and Home Guards for a period of not less than three years
4. No person who has been convicted by a competent court or who has been dismissed or removed on grounds of misconduct or moral turpitude while serving in any of the armed forces of the Union, State Police Organisations, Central or State Governments or in any private security agency shall be employed or engaged as a private security guard or a supervisor
5. The Controlling Authority or any other officer authorised by it in this behalf may at any reasonable time, enter the premises of the private security agency and inspect and examine the place of business, the records, accounts and other documents connected with the licence and may take copy of any document.
6. Office staff should be available during working hours for any in-person inquiry/review at the registered office premise.
7. A 24*7 helpline number (point of contact) to be made available for any assistance and grievance redressal.
8. There shall be monitoring of enrolled staff, service and supporting documents on ad hoc basis to curb any non-compliance
9. Operational Effectiveness should adhere to all audits, any change in norms and advisories when made official with due diligence.
10. If any private security guard or supervisor wears the uniform of the Army, Air force, Navy or any other armed forces of the Union or Police or any dress having the appearance or bearing any of the distinctive marks of that uniform, he and the proprietor of the private security agency shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to one year or with fine which may extend to five thousand rupees, or with both.

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
